**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR KINDERGARTEN AND
FIRST GRADE AS FIRST YEAR IN SCHOOL**

The State of Illinois and the Waukegan Board of Education requires that each student provide proof of having met the following health requirements for school entrance.

1. EVIDENCE OF A PHYSICAL EXAMINATION by a State Licensed Health Care Provider (using the "Certificate of Child Examination" form), completed after August 1st of the year before entering.
2. MEDICAL VERIFICATION OF COMPLETE IMMUNIZATION HISTORY; which states month, day, year, and signature of the doctor or nurse for each immunization below:
 - a. DPT: At least 4 doses, with the last booster on or after 4th birthday.
 - b. POLIO: At least 4 doses, with the last booster on or after 4th birthday.
 - c. MEASLES: The first dose after 12 months of age and the second dose no sooner than one month later.
 - d. RUBELLA: One dose on or after 12 months of age.
 - e. MUMPS: One dose on or after 12 months of age.
 - f. HEPATITIS B: A series of three doses.
 - g. HIB: One or more doses, with the last dose on or after 12 months of age.
 - h. VARICELLA: One dose on or after 12 months of age
3. MEDICAL VERIFICATION AND RESULTS OF A TUBERCULOSIS SKIN TEST completed after August 1st, of the year before entering school for the first time.
4. MEDICAL VERIFICATION OF LEAD SCREENING is required for all entering kindergarten , or if under age 7 and entering the district for the first time. If screening determines the student is at risk, proof of blood testing, according to the Illinois Department of Public Health, is also required.
5. MEDICAL VERIFICATION OF DIABETES SCREENING and results.
6. A DENTAL EXAMINATION **is required for students entering kindergarten.**

ALL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS MUST BE TURNED IN BY THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Your child may NOT re-enter school until ALL health requirements are turned in.
Appointment dates will NOT be accepted.
